Basic daily fee: A daily fee of \$63.82 is applicable to all residents (including those in respite care) regardless of which residence you choose. It is set by the Department of Health and Aged Care as a contribution to cover the costs of daily living. This fee will be reviewed on 20 September 2025.

Means-tested care fee: A fee individually calculated by Services Australia based on an assessment of your income and assets (not applicable to all people).
